I wish to take this opportunity to thank our corporate and alumni contributors alike for their important investments of funding. volunteerism, and input to make the IALF and our leadership program better.


In closing, the IALF thanks our supporters, participants, Board and staff for their dedication to propel our Foundation and premier agricultural leadership program towards a bright future.
