

In closing, the IALF thanks our supporters, participants, Board and staff for their dedication to propel our Foundation and premier agricultural leadership program towards a bright future.

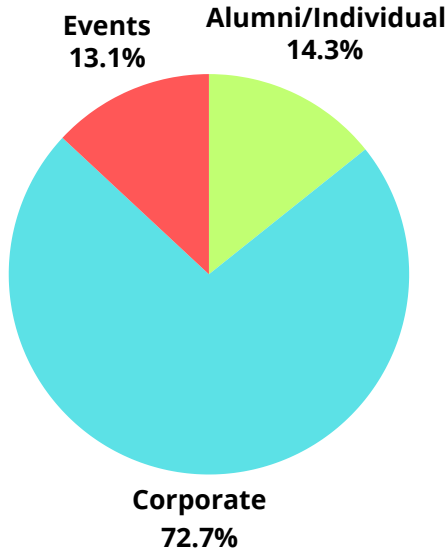
